“Rochester Junior Woman’s Club is looking for New Members”

Members of RJWC have helped found many institutions in the Rochester community; Rochester Community House, Crittenton Hospital, Rochester Hills Public Library, Rochester YMCA, Older Persons Commission (OPC) and the League of Women Voters all were started with the support of club members.

The group also provides hands on support to the Paint Creek Center for the Arts, Rochester Hills Museum at VanHoosen Farm including the annual Stonewall Pumpkin Festival, the Older Persons Commission, and Dinosaur Hill Nature Center.

In addition, recent fundraisers have benefitted South Oakland Shelter, Meadowbrook Hall Garden Club, and Rochester Hills Museum, Meadowbrook Center for Learning Differences and Paint a Miracle in addition to an annual fundraiser for the Crittenton Hospital Auxiliary.

Funds raised this year will benefit OPC, Rainbow Connection Special Response Program and the Rochester Area Neighborhood House Food Pantry among other local charities.

Rochester Junior Woman’s Club welcomes new members all year long. Meetings are held the third Thursday of every month, September through May at the Rochester Community House at 7:00 p.m.

There will also be two additional Orientation Meetings, January 22nd, 2009 and April 29th, 2009. Both meetings will be held at the Rochester Community House, 816 Ludlow, in Downtown Rochester, at 7:00 pm.
