Rochester, MI August 25, 2008 --The Rochester Junior Woman’s Club is preparing for its 10th annual Lobster Boil on Saturday, September 27th.

The whole New England lobsters are flown in fresh early that morning and are between 1 and 1 ¼ pounds each. RJWC will be cooking the lobsters on-site at the Older Persons’ Commission located at 650 Letica in Rochester.

It’s a great way to entertain friends and family or enjoy a quiet dinner for two. You choose the pick-up time and they will cook them, wrap them, and have them hot and ready for you at the OPC drive-thru site. You don’t even have to get out of your car! The lobsters will stay HOT for up to 2 hours in the wrappers.

Orders will be taken through September 19th for live or cooked lobsters. If you prefer to order your lobsters live, please bring a container to transport them home. The lobsters are \$17.00 each. Buy baker’s dozen and get the 13th free.

Proceeds from this year’s Lobster Boil will benefit the Rochester Area Neighborhood House Food Pantry, Rainbow Connection’s Special Response Program, the OPC and other local charities.
